Registration fees are per trainee. Registrations are confirmed after receipt of payment. Cedre is accredited under the French Internal Security Code (article L. 725-1, L. 725-3 and R. 725-1 to R. 725-11). Accreditation from the French Directorate-General for Civil Protection and Crisis Management by the interministerial order of 22 January 2019 which officially recognises Cedre's capacity to work alongside government services in pollution response operations in French waters under the French emergency organisation ORSEC. Cedre is also accredited in accordance with articles L. 211-5-1 and R. 211-120 to R. 211-122 of the French Code of the Environment by France's Ministry for the Ecological Transition and Ministry of the Sea to conduct missions of general interest providing expertise and support for the authorities including the organisation of training courses by a team of professional trainers on the management of and response to oil or chemical spills at sea, in sea ports, on the shoreline, in lakes and in watercourses. This accreditation gave rise to the ministerial order issued on 15 December 2020. The continuing professional training courses that Cedre has been providing since 1985 are intended for technicians and managers from industrial and service companies, administrations, public establishments, local authorities and associations.
